ORDINANCE NO. 84-7

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE VACATING A CERTAIN PORTION OF AN UNNAMED ALLEY LYING BETWEEN NORTH 14TH. STREET EXTENSION AND SLOAN AVENUE, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH RANKIN AVENUE 178.91 FEET IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette at a regular meeting thereof held on the 4TH day of APRIL, 1984 that,

WHEREAS, Council has received a petition from a majority in number and interest of the property owners abutting a certain unimproved portion of an unnamed alley lying between North 14th. Street Extension and Sloan Avenue, from its intersection with Rankin Avenue proceeding in a Southerly direction a distance of 178.91 feet, to vacate same, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and;

WHEREAS, the petition has been reviewed by the Fire Chief, Police Chief and City Engineer and no objections to the proposed vacation has been found.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above and intending to be legally bound hereby, Council adopts the following:

- 1) That portion of an unimproved unnamed alley, lying between North 14th. Street Extension and Sloan Avenue, from its intersection with Rankin, 178.91 feet in a southerly direction to a point shall be and is hereby vacated.
- 2) That portion of unimproved alley hereby vacated shall revert to and become the property of those property owners abutting along said portion of ground.
- 3) Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- 4) This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage.
