ORDINANCE NO. 87-12

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE VACATING A CERTAIN UNOPENED AND UNIMPROVED PORTION OF SOUTH THIRD STREET, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH DIVISION STREET IN A GENERAL NORTHERLY DIRECTION, 88.31 FEET TO A POINT, SAID POINT BEING ON THE DIVIDING LINE BETWEEN LOTS 430 AND 428 IN THE TOWN OF JEANNETTE PLAN OF LOTS, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY SET FORTH IN THE DIAGRAM ATTACHED HERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 24TH day of SEPTEMBER, 1987, that

WHEREAS: Council has received a petition executed by a majority of number and interest of the property owners situate along a portion of South Third Street to vacate said portion of Street, and;

WHEREAS; The portion of South Third Street has never been improved or opened, and;

WHEREAS, The City Engineer has reviewed the proposed vacation and recommends that any existing easements or right of ways be retained and reserved.

NOW, THEREFORE, intending to be legally bound, Council adopts the following:

1. That portion of South Third Street beginning at its intersection with Division Street and proceeding in a general northerly direction of 88.31 to a point on the boundry line between Lots 430 and 428 in the Town of Jeannette Plan, being also of equal width of 50 feet be and is hereby vacated, provided however that any existing easements or right of ways for municipal services as specially excepted and reserved from the operation of this ordinance.

2. The vacated portion of street shall hereby revert to the adjoining property owners as determined from the centerline thereof.


