AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE
NAMING A CERTAIN UNNAMED TWENTY (20)
FOOT ALLEY SITUATE BETWEEN COWAN AVENUE
ON THE NORTH AND PATTON AVENUE ON THE SOUTH

Be it ordained and enacted and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 15TH day of FEBRUARY, 1989, that,

Whereas, Council has the authority to fix the names of certain unnamed streets or alleys pursuant to 53 P.S. 37403(60) which confers broad local self-government powers upon City Council, and

Whereas, Council desires to name a certain unnamed twenty (20) foot alley way in the City, and

Whereas, Council desires to pay tribute to Reverend Benno Brink, O.S.B., former pastor of Sacred Heart Church, and

Whereas, the unnamed alley lies within the immediate vicinity of Sacred Heart Congregation,

Now therefore, in consideration of the above, Council adopts the following:

1. That certain unnamed twenty (20) foot alley way, lying between Cowan Avenue on the North and Patton Avenue on the South, between North Seventh Street on the West and North Fifth Street on the East is hereby named Benno Way.

2. The City Engineer is hereby directed to make the necessary changes on the official map of the City of Jeannette


to effect this change and to further notify whatever appropriate agencies are necessary to confirm this change.
