ORDINANCE NO. 91-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE  
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 56-1 AND PRO-  
VIDING FOR THE MANDATORY USE OF PLASTIC  
GARBAGE BAGS, REQUIRING THAT THE BAGS  
BE PURCHASED FROM THE CITY, SETTING THE  
PRICE FOR EACH BAG, SETTING THE HOURS  
WHICH BAGS CAN BE PURCHASED.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette, at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1991, that

**WHEREAS:** Council has the specific authority to provide for the collection, removal and disposal of garbage, rubbish and ashes in 53 P.S. 37403 (6) and;

**WHEREAS:** The City has previously enacted Ordinance No. 56-1 as amended, and;

**WHEREAS:** To promote the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the City of Jeannette, Council adopts the following:


1. From the effective date of this Ordinance, all garbage, rubbish and refuse in the City of Jeannette shall be placed for collection in plastic bags furnished by the City.
2. The Bags shall be available for purchase from the City during normal business hours from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday, in the City Treasurer's Office.
3. The cost of the bags shall be .25 per bag.
4. No garbage, rubbish or ashes shall be placed for collection by any person, family or domestic unit unless it is in garbage bags furnished by the City.
5. It shall be unlawful to place any garbage, refuse or rubbish to be collected in any container except garbage bags supplied by the City, provided however, that certain commercial and industrial accounts shall be permitted to place garbage, rubbish or ashes for collection in dumpsters, specifically approved by the City.

6. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense, and upon convicting thereof shall pay a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$50.00
  
7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, but the effective date of the provision requiring the use of the bags shall be March 18, 1991.
