ORDINANCE NO. 92-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE  
AMENDING CERTAIN ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR  
VEHICLES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR  
VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1992 that:

**WHEREAS:** The City has previously enacted Ordinances regulating the parking of motor vehicles upon City streets and proscribing penalties thereof and,

**WHEREAS:** The City desires to amend the schedule of fines and costs for violation of the parking regulations, and,

**WHEREAS:** The City has specific authority to regulate parking upon City streets as set forth at 53 P.S. and:

**WHEREAS:** The City desires to promote the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Jeannette.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the above, Council adopts the following:

- 1) The fine for overtime parking at a parking meter shall be \$1.00, provided it is paid on the first day of the violation. Specifically, the day shall end at 12:00 A.M. (midnight) on the date of the violation and not a 24 hour period from the time of the violation.
2. If the fine is not paid on the 1st. day, then the fine shall be increased by an additional \$2.00
3. The fines for all parking violations shall be as set forth in the following schedule:



No Parking Zone	\$ 3.00
Loading Zone	
(Excess of 15 min.)	\$ 3.00

Corner Ordinance	\$ 3.00
Blocking Traffic Line	\$ 3.00
Fire Hydrant	\$ 3.00
City Hall Business Only	\$ 3.00
Parking by Permit Only	\$ 3.00
Handicapped	\$ 5.00

4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
