ORDINANCE NO. 18-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 14-02 RELATING TO THE POSITION OF CITY MANAGER AND TO PERMIT THE REASSIGNMENT OF SUCH POWERS AND DUTIES.

WHEREAS, the prior City Council of the City of Jeannette enacted Ordinance No. 14-02, creating the position of City Manager and providing for the powers of duties of such office; and

WHEREAS, the Third Class City Code, 11 Pa.C.S.A. § 12435, permits City Council to repeal previously-enacted ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the current City Council desires to repeal Ordinance No. 14-02 and permit the reassignment of such powers and duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Jeannette hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

- Section 1. Repeal of Ordinance 14-02. Ordinance 14-02, relating to the position of City Manager, is repealed.
- Section 2. Reassignment of Powers and Duties. The powers and duties of the City Manager, as described in Section 6 of Ordinance 14-02 may be reassigned by City Council, by resolution or otherwise and in accordance with the Third Class City Code and applicable law, to other City officials and employees as may be determined by City Council.
- Section 3. Severability. It is herein declared that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any provisions, portions, or sections of this Ordinance are declared to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, the decisions of any Court, which makes declarations, shall not impair or affect any of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
