ORDINANCE NO. 18-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE,  
WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR  
ONE WAY TRAFFIC ALONG THE 500 BLOCK OF COWAN  
AVENUE IN THE CITY OF JEANNETTE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jeannette has determined that the flow of traffic from on the 500 block of Cowan Avenue between North Seventh Street and Beno Way due to the nature of the avenue, could result in danger or damages to persons or property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jeannette desires to regulate the direction of traffic along the 500 block of Cowan Avenue to prevent its movement Westward between North Seventh Street and Beno Way, and

WHEREAS, the Engineer of the City of Jeannette and the Chief of Police of the City of Jeannette have recommended that the 500 block of Cowan Avenue be restricted to one-way traffic flowing Eastward from North Seventh Avenue to Beno Way, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jeannette believes that such restriction is necessary to ensure safe passage upon the 500 block of Cowan Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Jeannette hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

1. That travel upon the 500 block of Cowan Avenue shall be limited to "One Way", with the flow of traffic restricted to an easterly direction of travel.
2. The portion of Cowan Avenue subject to such restriction shall be between the intersections of North Seventh Street and Beno Way.
3. The Chief of Police, City Engineer and City Foreman are hereby directed to post appropriate signs at the intersection of Cowan Avenue and North Seventh Street and the intersection of Beno Way and Cowan Avenue.
4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance is duly ORDAINED AND ENACTED by a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Jeannette at a duly advertised public meeting held on the 24th day of April, 2018.
