ORDINANCE NO. 18-20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING PART 5, THE TRAFFIC CODE, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ADD A STOP INTERSECTION ON CHAMBER AVENUE AND PUBLIC HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES ON SOUTH EIGHTH STREET; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there exists within the City of Jeannette certain areas where stop signs are necessary to protect the traveling public and handicapped parking of vehicles is needed to provide safe and adequate parking for handicapped persons; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette has previously adopted a Traffic Control Map and maintains a Traffic Control File; and

WHEREAS, a study has been conducted and it has been determined that it is warranted for the eastbound intersection of Chambers Avenue by South Sixth Street to be deemed a stop intersection requiring the installation of stop signs eastbound on Chambers Avenue at its intersection with South Sixth Street; and

WHEREAS, a study has been conducted and it has been determined that it is warranted for handicapped parking spaces be provided and the requisite signage be installed eastbound on South Eighth Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette has the power to erect official traffic-control devices pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 6122, 67 Pa. Code § 212.5, and other statutory and regulatory sections.

WHEREAS, the Third Class City Code, 53 P.S. 37403(60), affords the City of Jeannette with the power “to make and adopt all such ordinances, by-laws, rules and regulations, not inconsistent with or restrained by the Constitution and laws of this Commonwealth, as may be expedient or necessary for the proper management, care and control of the city and its finances, and the maintenance of the peace, good government, safety and welfare of the city, and its trade, commerce and manufactures.”

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Jeannette, Fayette County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1. Addition of Chambers Avenue and South Sixth Street as a Stop Intersection. The City hereby declares and designates the eastbound intersection of Chambers Avenue by South Sixth Street as a stop intersection, such that stop signs and all other

appropriate signage and markings required by applicable PennDOT regulations shall be installed eastbound on Chambers Avenue at its intersection with South Sixth Street (e.g., persons traveling on Chambers Avenue must stop at the intersection with South Sixth Street prior to entering said intersection). The City's Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File shall be revised and updated to include said stop signs and any existing traffic signs, signals, zones, designations, and maps presently existing and not otherwise amended herein.

Section 2. Addition of Handicapped Parking Spaces on South Eighth Street. The City hereby establishes and places one (1) handicapped parking space on South Eighth Street between Clay Avenue and Bullitt Avenue, such that handicapped parking signs and all other appropriate signage and markings required by applicable PennDOT regulations shall be installed for such handicapped parking space on South Eight Street. The City's Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File shall be revised and updated to include said handicapped parking signs and any existing traffic signs, signals, zones, designations, and maps presently existing and not otherwise amended herein.

Section 3. Severability. It is herein declared that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any provisions, portions, or sections of this Ordinance are declared to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, the decisions of any Court, which makes declarations, shall not impair or affect any of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repealer. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance that conflicts with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict on the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after its enactment.

This Ordinance is duly ORDAINED AND ENACTED by a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Jeannette at a duly advertised public meeting held on the 13th day of December, 2018.
