ORDINANCE NO. 19-07

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-11, AS AMENDED, TO ADD PORTIONS OF BRICKELL AVENUE AS PERMIT PARKING; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, there exists within the City of Jeannette certain areas where parking of vehicles upon the roadways interferes with emergency and other public or essential services or travel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette has established no parking areas within the City with Ordinance No. 98-11; and

WHEREAS, a study has been conducted and it has been determined that with respect to portions of Brickell Avenue the conditions on such street and the surrounding neighborhood are crowded and congested such that parking is difficult for residents; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of such street and the surrounding neighborhood requires that such street become permit parking; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette has the power to erect official traffic-control devices pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 6122, 67 Pa. Code § 212.5, and other statutory and regulatory sections.

**BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Jeannette, Fayette County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

**Section 1.** Confirmation or Addition of Portions of Certain Streets as Permit Parking. The City hereby amends Ordinance No. 98-11, Section 1, as amended, to confirm or to add the following portions of roadways as permitted parking only:

- a. The West side of Brickell Avenue from North 8th Street to North 6th Street;

**Section 2.** Authorization. The City hereby authorizes all City officials and employees to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate and enforce the addition of said portion of roadways as permit parking only and this Ordinance, including, without limitation, the erection of any sign and the painting of any curbing or streetway.

**Section 3.** Severability. It is herein declared that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if any provisions, portions, or sections of this Ordinance are declared to be illegal,

invalid, or unconstitutional, the decisions of any Court, which makes declarations, shall not impair or affect any of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** Repealer. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance that conflicts with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict on the effective date of this ordinance.

**Section 5.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.

This Ordinance is duly ORDAINED AND ENACTED by a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Jeannette at a duly advertised public meeting held on the 11th day of April, 2019.
