RESOLUTION NO. 98-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE PURSUANT TO SECTION 1.10.14 OF PUBLICATION 46 ISSUED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PERTAINING TO THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF OVERHEAD BANNERS BY A MUNICIPALITY ACROSS A STATE HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS: the City of Jeannette Fourth of July Celebration (hereinafter the "Committee") is an unincorporated association formed for the purposes of scheduling a parade and related activities commemorating the independence of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS: the Committee has requested the cooperation of the City of Jeannette in participating in various events and affairs associated with a Fourth of July celebration to be held from July 3, 1998 to July 7, 1998; and

WHEREAS: such participation of the City of Jeannette includes, but may not be limited to, the construction of certain temporary signs or banners across two (2) state highways which are major transportation arteries running through the City of Jeannette, County of Westmoreland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to recent revisions to Section 1.10.14 of Publication 46 issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, effective January 1, 1997, it is incumbent upon the City of Jeannette to pass a Resolution designating its intention to erect such signs or banners and request the issuance of a permit from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation giving permission of the Department of Transportation for the construction of such signs and banners.

NOW, THEREFORE WITH THE FOREGOING RECITALS BEING INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE THERETO, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That, upon receipt of a permit from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, the City of Jeannette intends to construct across two (2) State Highways situate within the City of Jeannette, two (2) banners advertising a Fourth of July Celebration and Parade to be conducted within the City of Jeannette.

2. One of the aforesaid banners shall be constructed across Lowry Avenue, North of its intersection with Park Street within the City of Jeannette, such installation location being specifically described as over State Route 4009, at segment 10.

3. The second such banner shall be across Harrison Avenue at or near its intersection with Good Street within the City of Jeannette, such installation location being specifically described as across State Route 130, at segment 460, offset 1,822 feet.

4. The vertical clearance above the roadway for each banner shall not be less than seventeen (17') feet six (6") inches and shall be hung in such a fashion so as not to obstruct or otherwise interfere with vehicular traffic along such

5. The size of each banner shall not be greater than thirty (30") inches in width by twenty (20") feet in length.

6. The banner itself shall carry a message advertising and commemorating Jeannette Fourth of July Parade and Celebration as sponsored by the City of Jeannette Fourth of July Parade Committee.

7. The aforesaid banners shall be installed as soon as practicable following the receipt of the anticipated permit from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, the the intention of Council that such banners shall be constructed or hung on approximately May 30, 1998. Such banners shall continue to be displayed from the date same are constructed or hung until approximately July 8, 1998, the first Wednesday following the Fourth of July holiday weekend celebration.

8. The City of Jeannette shall be responsible for the erection, maintenance and removal of such banners and hereby assumes any liability for damages occurring to any person or property arising from any negligent act of omission associated with the sign or banner or its erection, maintenance and removal. In adopting this Resolution, it is the intent of the City to hold harmless the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation from any claims or damages associated with the issuance of the within permit or the construction, erection, maintenance or removal of the aforesaid banners. Nothing in this Resolution should be deemed or construed, however, to impose strict liability upon the City for damages to third parties not occasioned by a negligent act of ~~ommi~~mission of the

City of its employees.

9. No more than twenty (20%) percent of the banner or the message upon same will relate to the name or advertising of any commercial product, enterprise, business or company regardless of whether they are sponsoring the event or banner installation.

10. Traffic control for the erection and removal of such banner or any maintenance performed thereupon will be performed by the City in accordance with the most current Publication 203 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation relating to same.

11. This Resolution shall be considered an application to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for a permit to construct, maintain and remove the banners hereinabove described.

THIS RESOLUTION is duly Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the City of Jeannette at a public meeting held the 13th. Day of May, 1998.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, PENNSYLVANIA APPROVING THE REDEVELOPMENT AREA PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL JEANNETTE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND THE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION STRATEGY IN THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS: there has been prepared and referred to the City Council of the City of Jeannette (herein called the "Governing Body") for its review and approval, the REDEVELOPMENT AREA PLAN for the Central Jeannette Redevelopment Project, dated December 1997, and the Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy, dated December 1997; and

WHEREAS: the Planning Commission of the City of Jeannette has approved the Redevelopment Area Plan for the Central Jeannette Redevelopment Project Area and the Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy in the City of Jeannette; and

WHEREAS: the members of the Governing Body has general knowledge of the conditions prevailing in the Redevelopment Project Area and the Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Jeannette as follows:

1. That is hereby found and determined that the Project area qualifies as an eligible Redevelopment Area under the Pa Urban Redevelopment Law of 1945, as amended.

2. That it is hereby found and determined that the Redevelopment Area Plan for the Central Jeannette Redevelopment Project conforms to the general plan of the City of Jeannette.

3. That the Redevelopment Area Plan for the Central Jeannette Redevelopment Project, having been duly reviewed and considered, is hereby in all respects approved, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a copy of said Redevelopment Area Plan with the minutes of this meeting.

4. That in order to implement and facilitate the effectuation of the Redevelopment Area Plan, it is hereby approved and found by this Body that it: (a) pledges its cooperation in helping to carry out Redevelopment Area Plan: (b) requests the various officials, departments, boards, and agencies of the locality having administrative responsibilities in the premises
