RESOLUTION NO. 98-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE PURSUANT TO SECTION 1.10.14 OF PUBLICATION 46 ISSUED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PERTAINING TO THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF OVERHEAD BANNERS BY A MUNICIPALITY ACROSS A STATE HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS: The Jeannette Varsity Football/Cheerleader's Mother's Club (hereinafter the "Club") is an unincorporated association formed for the purpose of financially supporting the Jeannette Senior High School Varsity Football Team and the Varsity Cheerleaders Squad.

WHEREAS: The Club has requested the cooperation of the City of Jeannette to participate in certain events.

WHEREAS: Such participation of the City of Jeannette includes the construction of certain temporary Banner across one (1) state highway which is a major transportation artery running through the City of Jeannette, County of Westmoreland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to recent revisions to Section 1.10.14 of Publication 46 issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, effective January 1, 1997, it is incumbent upon the City of Jeannette to pass a Resolution designating its intention to erect such a Banner and request the issuance of a permit from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation giving permission of the Department of Transportation for the construction of such Banner.

NOW, THEREFORE, WITH THE FOREGOING RECITALS BEING INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE THERETO, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That, upon receipt of a permit from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, the City of Jeannette intends to construct across one (1) State Highway situate within the City of Jeannette one (1) Banner welcoming visitors to Jayhawk Country.

2. This Banner shall be constructed across Lowry Avenue, North of its intersection with Park Street within the City of Jeannette, such installation location being specifically described as over State Route 409, at segment 10.

3. The vertical clearance above the roadway for this Banner shall not be less than seventeen (17') feet six (6") inches and shall be hung in such a fashion so as not to obstruct or otherwise interfere with vehicular traffic along such.

4. The size of each banner shall not be greater than thirty (30") inches in width by twenty (20') feet in length.

5. The Banner itself shall carry a message, "WELCOME TO JAYHAWK COUNTRY, HOME OF CHAMPIONS.

6. The aforesaid Banner shall be installed as soon as practicable following the receipt of the anticipated permit from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, with the intention of Council that such Banner shall be constructed or hung on approximately August 17, 1998. Such Banner shall continue to be displayed from the date same constructed or hung until approximately November 27, 1998.

7. The City of Jeannette shall be responsible for the erection, maintenance and removal of such banners and hereby assumes any liability for damages occurring to any person or property arising from any negligent act or omission associated with the Sign or Banner or its erection, maintenance and removal of the aforesaid Banner. Nothing in this Resolution should be deemed or construed, however, to impose liability upon the City for damages to third parties not occasioned by a negligent act or omission of the City or its Employees.

8. No more than twenty (20) percent of the Banner or the message upon same will relate to the name or advertising of any commercial product, enterprise, business or company regardless of whether they are sponsoring the event or Banner in installation.

9. Traffic control for the erection and removal of such Banner or any maintenance performed thereupon will be performed by the City in accordance with the most current publication 203 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation relating to same.

10. This Resolution shall be considered an application to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation for a permit to construct, maintain and remove the Banner herein described.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLI-
CATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE PENNSYLV-
LVANIA COMMISSION ON CRIME AND DELINQUENCY
FOR NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY MAINTENANCE.**

WHEREAS: The City of Jeannette has been approached by Westmoreland Human Opportunities, Inc., a "not for profit" corporation performing community service projects within the City of Jeannette, to initiate programs to improve neighborhood safety; and

WHEREAS: The Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency has made available funding to municipalities and "not for profit" organizations to continue and expand current initiatives within municipalities to improve neighborhood safety; and

WHEREAS: The Council of the City of Jeannette believes it is in the best interests of the City to promote crime prevention and neighborhood safety through the initiation of Risk Management and Early Intervention Programs within the City; and

WHEREAS: The City of Jeannette, in conjunction with Westmoreland Human Opportunities, Inc., desires to initiate those programs set forth in the Project Narrative attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A", and to obtain funding for same through the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency.

NOW, THEREFORE, WITH THE FOREGOING RECITALS BEING INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE THERETO, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE, AT A PUBLIC MEETING HELD AUGUST 12, 1998, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Jeannette shall make application to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency for the sum of \$29,899.99 to fund the Community Crime Prevention Initiative as described in the Project Narrative attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

2. The Mayor of the City of Jeannette shall be authorized to execute the "Single Application for Assistance" for such funding attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
