RESOLUTION 18-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE APPROVING AND ADOPTING A 5% COMMISSION ON THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL SANITATION (GARBAGE) BALANCES PAID MONTHLY TO CITY TREASURER JACOB MILLIRON.

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette recognizes the time and effort exhausted by the Treasurer's Office in regards to collection of delinquent (past due) garbage (sanitation) balances. The City of Jeannette further recognizes the additional time spent researching accounts, mailing violations, attending court hearings, and any other actions association with the collection process has been provided to the City at no additional cost.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Jeannette that:

- 1) A 5% commission of any and all DELINQUENT balance(s) collected on both residential and commercial accounts shall be payable to and paid directly to City Treasurer Jacob Milliron under the following conditions, requirements, and specifications:
 - a) The commission shall be paid to City Treasurer Jacob Milliron monthly for the previous month's collection(s) upon submission of a complete report showing the total amount of delinquent balances (as defined herein) collected by the City Treasurer's Office for such month.
 - b) "Delinquent balance(s)" shall mean any residential and commercial garbage (sanitation) past due account balances and/or penalties that are more than one (1) day past due.
 - c) The commissions shall be paid on collections retroactive to January 1, 2018.
 - d) The commissions shall be paid in accordance with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations, including, with limitation, any federal or state tax laws.

RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ADOPTED at a meeting held on the 11th day of January, 2018.
