

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF JEANNETTE,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA
APPROVING THE BUDGET MODIFICATION
OF THE FY 2020 CDBG-CV PROGRAM
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09**

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette is a recipient of Community Development Block Grant Covid-19 (CDBG-CV) funds through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (PA DCED) has provided a grant to the City of Jeannette under the FY 2020 CDBG-CV Program to address the effects of the Covid-19 Virus by funding activities that will prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, there is a balance of funds remaining in the PPE Line Item under the FY 2020 CDBG-CV Program Year; and

WHEREAS, the City will no longer fund the Housing Assistance Line Item, Parent Chromebook training, and the Food Pantry Activity; and

WHEREAS, this Budget Modification was presented at a public City Council Meeting to give residents the opportunity to comment on the proposed revision; and

WHEREAS, the City's staff and Consultant have prepared a Budget Modification which consists of the following:

FY 2020 CDBG-CV PROGRAM

1. Reduce the budget amount for the purchase of PPE from \$49,880.00 to \$49,866.70.
2. Delete the budget amount for the Housing Assistance Payments of \$84,400.00.
3. Delete the budget amount for the Parent Chromebook Training of \$7,225.00.
4. Delete the budget amount for the Food Pantry Activity of \$30,000.00.
5. Add a Small Business Grant Program with the remaining CDBG-CV funds for \$121,638.30.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Jeannette, hereby approves the proposed Budget Modification to the FY 2020 CDBG-CV Program and authorizes the filing of said revision with the PA Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Jeannette is designated as the Chief Executive Officer authorized to execute all necessary documents on behalf of the City of Jeannette in regard to the FY 2020 CDBG-CV Program; and furthermore, is authorized and made responsible for performing the overall coordination and administration of the City's FY 2020 CDBG-CV Program.
