WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette is proud to join the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Office of Fair Housing & Equal Opportunity in celebrating the Anniversary of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, also known as the Fair Housing Act;

WHEREAS, the 1968 Fair Housing Act was created to provide equal housing opportunities to all Americans, regardless of race, color, religion, creed, national origin, ethnicity, ancestry, familial, status, disability, gender, or age; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette also joins the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in protecting individuals from discrimination based on sexual orientation or gender identity; and

WHEREAS, the proper enforcement of the Fair Housing Act requires the continued cooperation of all levels of government, real estate brokers/agencies, the construction industry, lending institutions, and private citizens, as well; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jeannette will cause to be provided, and promote fair housing and equal opportunity education and outreach in our community; and

WHEREAS, promoting equal housing opportunity is essential to the City’s larger mission of promoting justice for all citizens, and equal opportunity, diversity, and respect in our community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Jeannette, Westmoreland County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same as follows:



SECTION 2: Any Resolution or part of any Resolution that is conflicting herewith, or is repealed hereby, be and the same is hereby repealed.


